Overview & Purpose

Contents

Poster to promote Adult Learners' Week.

Prompt sheet poster and individual size with "I'm learning...and I'm sticking with it" to encourage learners to reflect and celebrate their past and future achievements.

Post-its to stick on the prompt sheet or poster with learners' accomplishments and ideas.

Use the prompt, "I'm learning...and I'm sticking with it" to:

- 1. Start a conversation.
- 2. Put up the prompt sheet in a classroom or learning space and invite everyone to add their voice in pen, pencil, drawing, on a post-it, etc!
- 3. Create a collection of stories or art work based on the theme.
- 4. Make a video.
- 5. Share some digital skills and put a presentation together.
- 6. Take photos of each learner holding up their answer on the prompt sheet.
